The processing of personal data via the BLANC & FISCHER Group's Onventis e-procurement platform is the joint responsibility of the Blanc and Fischer Corporate Services, BFITS, E.G.O., BLANCO and B.PRO groups, all of which are part of the BLANC & FISCHER Group. The exact company names can be found in Appendix 1 to this data protection notice. Corresponding contractual provisions have been agreed between the controllers in a contract on joint responsibility.

Purpose and legal basis of data processing

As part of e-procurement, employees of B&F companies can place orders for indirect goods and services. This includes all goods and services that are not directly incorporated into the product.

These are, for example, orders for the procurement of indirect goods such as office and business equipment, tool materials or IT supplies and services of any kind. Catalogues are available from which a selection of existing goods and services can be selected and ordered. The conditions for this are centrally negotiated and are available to the orders. If the required goods or services are not included in the catalogues, they must be applied for and checked by B&F Purchasing.

Depending on the location of the B&F company, there are different approval limits for the purchase orders, which are either sent directly to the supplier or must first be approved by B&F Purchasing and/or the respective supervisor or internal approver.

Orders placed can be viewed and traced by the respective users (orders). Order information is then transferred from Onventis to the SAP system and stored.

In addition to the first name, surname, organization and cost centre of the ordering party, the name of the releasing party and other order information are processed as part of the orders. Login to the system is done by means of single sign-on with the user data. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the necessity for the performance of a contract/order in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. b (GDPR contract/contractual pre-relationship).

Recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

As a platform for e-procurement, we use the system of the service provider Onventis GmbH. In addition, we make use of Blanc und Fischer IT Services GmbH, among other things, regarding the IT infrastructure and the provision of further funds for the implementation of the services with regard to e-procurement as well as technical support. We also use the SAP system of the service provider SAP Deutschland SE & Co. KG to store and manage orders. For this purpose, there are corresponding interfaces between the Onventis and SAP systems, which are provided and managed by our service provider Seeburger AG and Seeburger Deutschland GmbH & Co. KG.

Corresponding order processing agreements have been concluded with the service providers.

We only pass on your personal data within our company to those departments and persons who need it to carry out and carry out their tasks. These are the purchasing department and the corresponding specialist departments of the companies. In addition, we may also rely on other companies of the BLANC & FISCHER Group to provide the services/purposes described above if this is necessary for the implementation of the purposes. These may also include companies in third countries outside the EU.

Transfer to third countries

In principle, data processing takes place within the EU. However, access may also be possible from locations of the national subsidiaries of the BLANC & FISCHER Group. These can also be in third countries outside the EU. Corresponding safeguards for data transfers are provided by the adequacy decision for the respective country or EU standard contractual clauses that have been concluded. Regarding the Responsible Companies with locations outside the EU, the transfer and storage of personal data within the EU takes place on the basis of explicit consent.

Right to withdraw consent

Consent is voluntary and can be revoked at any time for the future. Please send this to your responsible contact person in the purchasing department of the BLANC & FISCHER Group. Please

note that the revocation of consent is associated with the deletion of your registration in e-procurement. Without consent, the registration and use of e-procurement cannot take place outside the EU.

Storage period in accordance with statutory retention obligations

To the extent necessary, we process and store your personal data in relation to the e-procurement of the BLANC & FISCHER Group only for as long as they are necessary to achieve the purposes. This is generally done when you remove your information from e-procurement or delete your account. The personal data is then deleted or anonymized. Statutory retention obligations remain unaffected by this. In this case, the data will be restricted and only stored for the legal retention purpose.

Right to information, correction, deletion, restriction, data portability and objection

As a data subject, you have the right to information (Art. 15 GDPR), correction (Art. 16 GDPR), deletion of your data (Art. 17 GDPR), restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR) and a right to object (Art. 21 GDPR) at any time. Please contact the responsible body using the contact details provided.

Right of appeal

In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a competent data protection supervisory authority in accordance with Art. 77 GDPR if you believe that the processing of your personal data is not lawful.
